- Incorporates cross-state collaboration features




Quality Criteria for Digital Library Resources

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Four Attributes of the Formative Assessment Process






Accessing the Digital Library



To access the Digital Library, go to http://www.caaspp.org and select the "Smarter Balanced Digital Library" button.




Digital Library Home Page




Selecting a Resource

Selecting a Resource




Many resources have downloadable materials. Make sure to select the "View All Materials" button for documents, presentation slides, or videos!


