

Bylaws of the BoardGoverning Board Elections

Governing board election procedures shall be conducted in accordance with the California Education Code and Election Code.

Any person is eligible to be a board member if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of the state, a resident of the school district, a registered voter and not legally disqualified from holding civil office. (Ed. Code 35107)

Statement of Qualifications

The board shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating or mailing candidate statements.

The secretary of the board shall notify the county clerk of this policy on or before the 125th day prior to each election of board members. (Elections Code 23510.5)

Tie Votes in Board Members Elections

Whenever a tie make it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the board, the board shall immediately notify the candidates who received the tie votes of the time and place where lots shall be cast to determine the winner. (Ed. Code 5016)
