



SBAC Preliminary, Grades 3-8, 11






SBAC Preliminary ELA Subgroup Performance

New Metric Distance From Level 3 (Standard Met)

- Key metric on the new State Dashboard
- Used to measure growth toward standards mastery over time
- Determined as follows for both ELA and Math:
 - ➤ The average of all scaled scores for grades 3-8 is calculated
 - The average is then compared to the cutoff score for Level 3 or Standard Met
- Formula for both ELA and Math:
 - ➤ (Level 3 Cutoff Score) (Average Score) = Distance from Level 3




New Metric Distance From Level 3 (Standard Met)





MATH DISTANCE FROM LEVEL 3




Early Assessment Program (EAP)

- 11th Grade SBAC Score = Standard Exceeded
 - "Ready for College"
 - Exempt from CSU placement tests
 - Exempt from most community college placement tests
 - Allowed to enroll in college-level courses
 - Does not apply to UC system
- 11th Grade SBAC Score = Standard Met
 - "Conditionally Ready for College"
 - Requires additional measures to be ready for college-level coursework at CSU and most community colleges

11th Grade EAP Preliminary Score Summary


