## New Metric Distance From Level 3 (Standard Met)

- Key metric on the new State Dashboard
- Used to measure growth toward standards mastery over time
- Determined as follows for both ELA and Math:
$\rightarrow$ The average of all scaled scores for grades 3-8 is calculated
$>$ The average is then compared to the cutoff score for Level 3 or Standard Met
- Formula for both ELA and Math:
$>($ Level 3 Cutoff Score) $-($ Average Score $)=$ Distance from Level 3

## Early Assessment Program (EAP)

- 11th Grade SBAC Score = Standard Exceeded
> "Ready for College"
> Exempt from CSU placement tests
> Exempt from most community college placement tests
> Allowed to enroll in college-level courses
$>$ Does not apply to UC system
- $11^{\text {th }}$ Grade SBAC Score = Standard Met
> "Conditionally Ready for College"
$>$ Requires additional measures to be ready for college-level coursework at CSU and most community colleges
