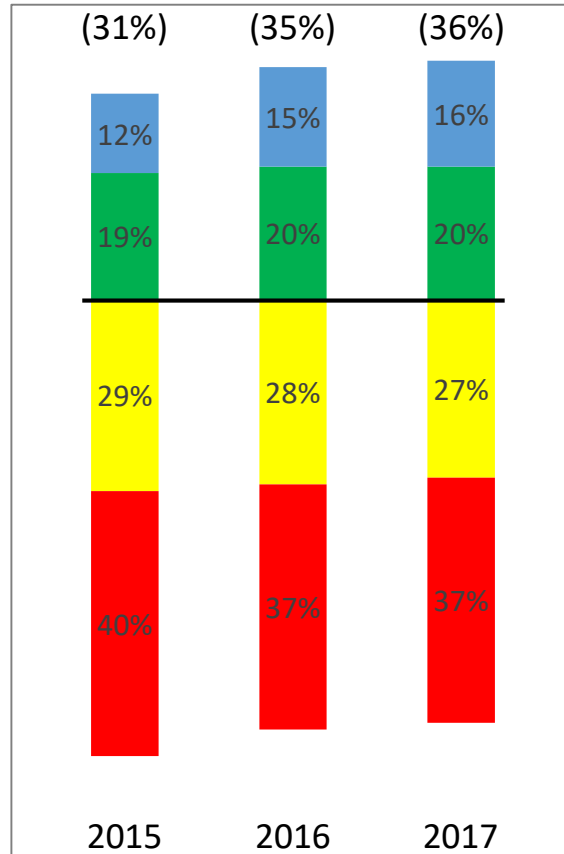

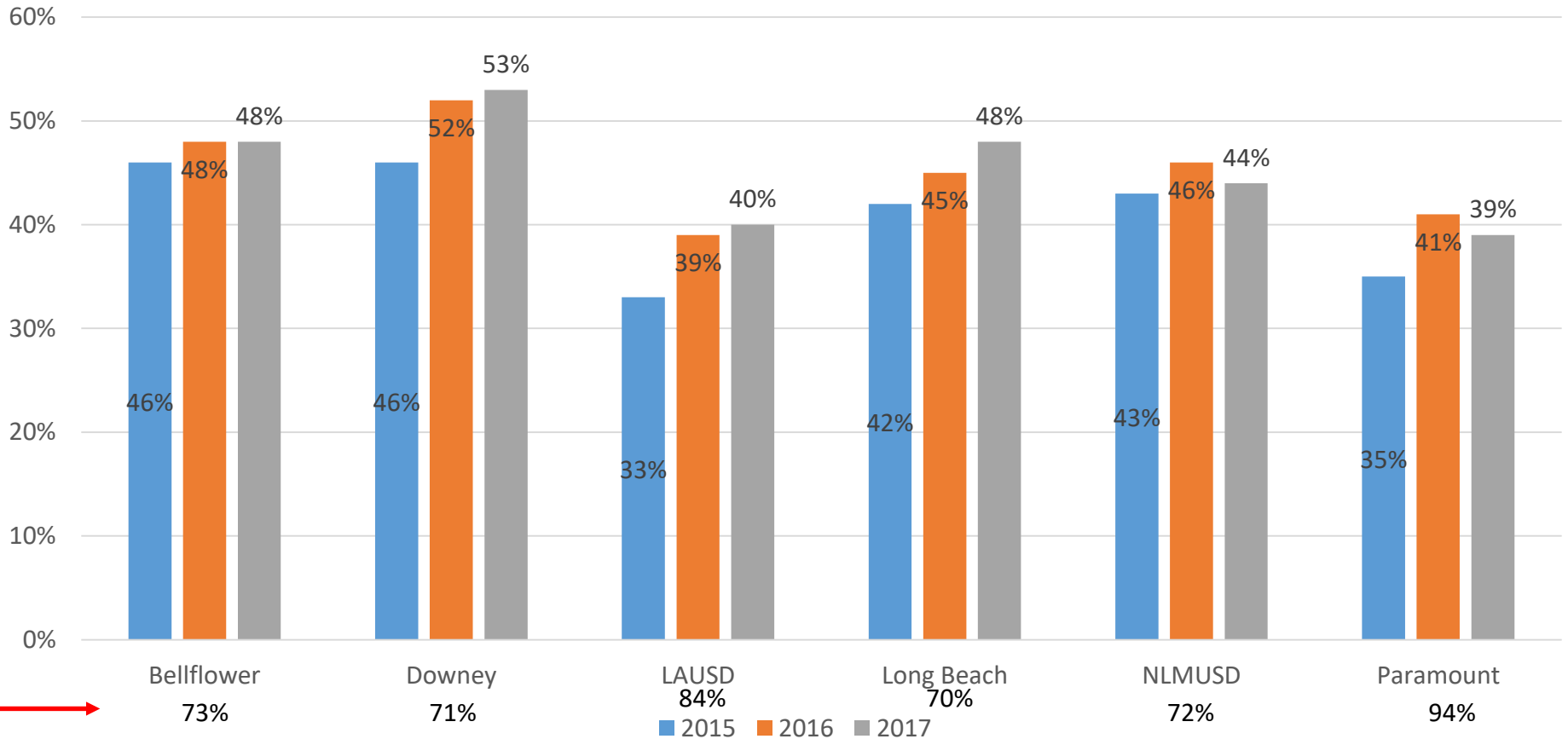

SBAC ELA - Local District Comparison

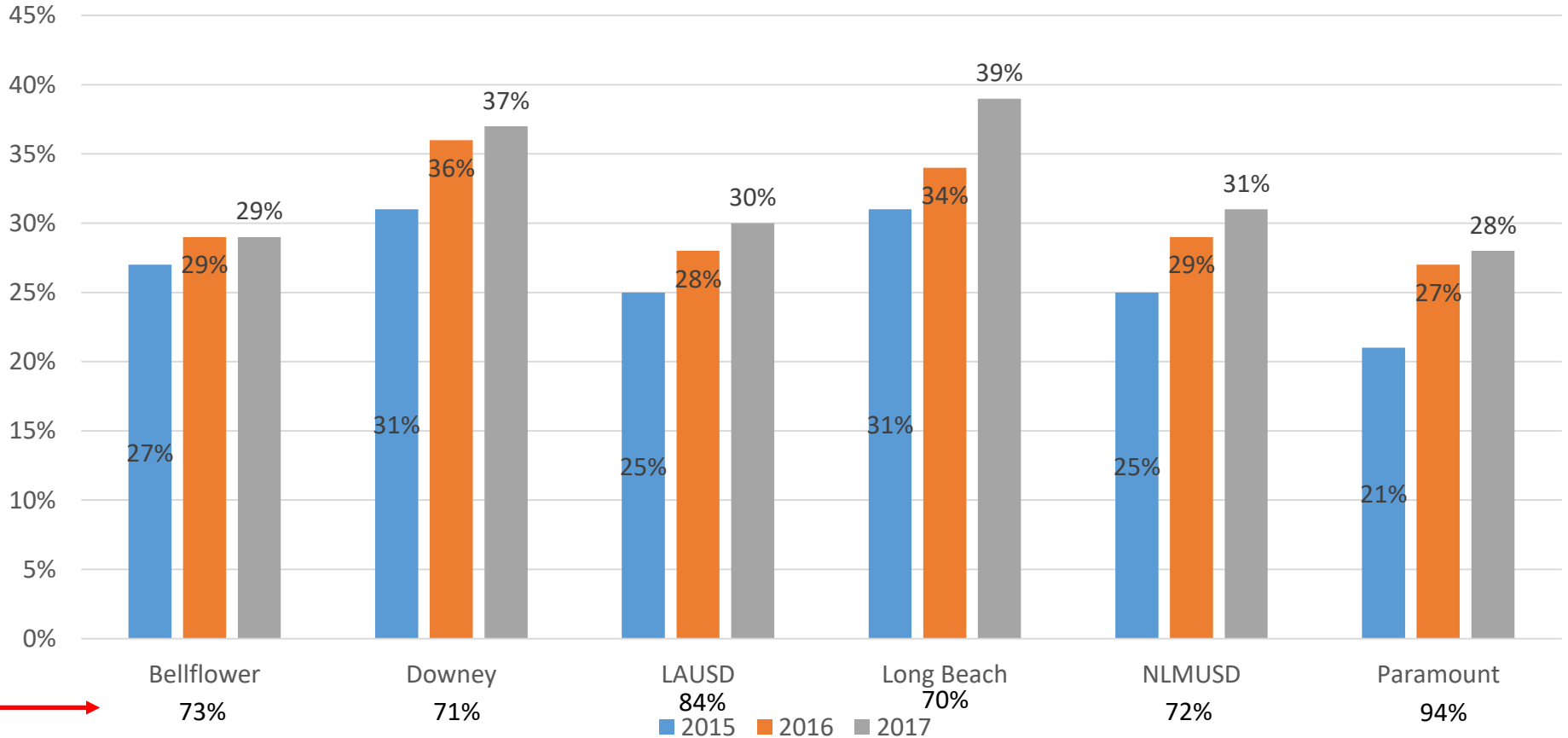
% Met or Exceeded Standards – All Grades

% Met or Exceeded Standards – All Grades

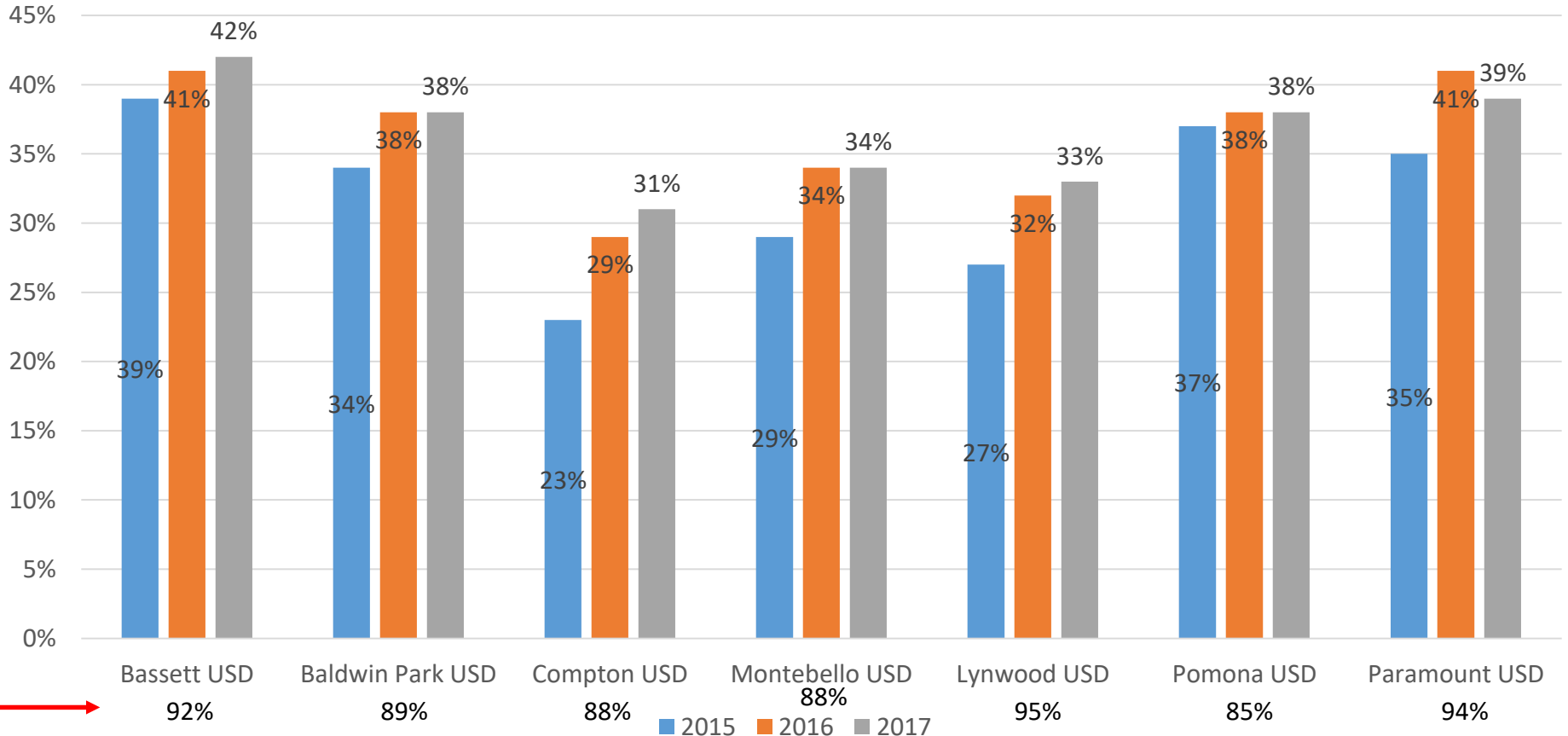

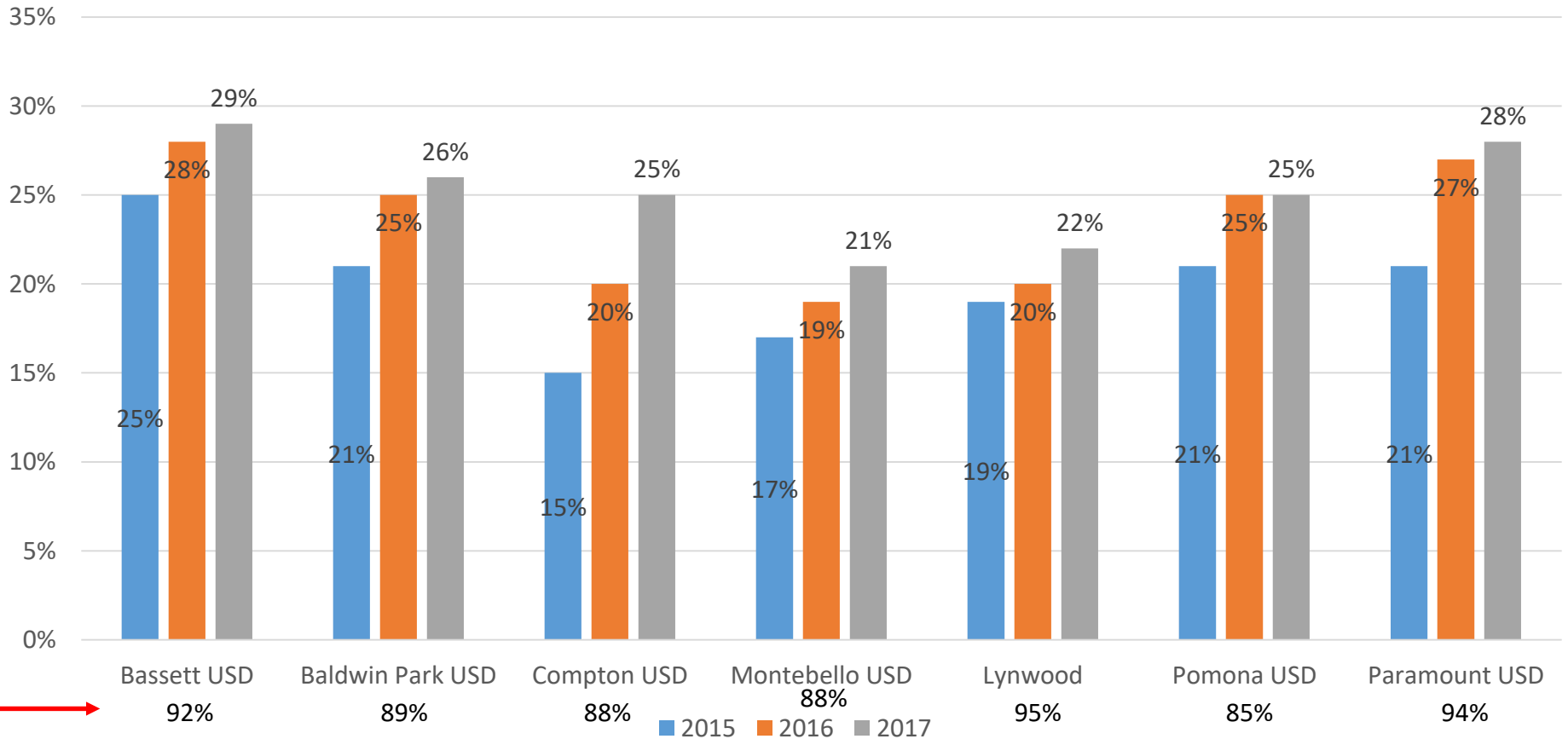

- CTE Pathways – Relevant and meaningful learning

- Embed additional test prep into 11th grade courses
- Show relevance of testing to students

Key steps for our elementary and middle schools moving forward.....

The following will take place to assure continued progress in 2017-18:

Support

- Professional development in ELD and writing for all K-5 teachers.
- Curriculum Specialists and Coaches co-teaching lessons with teachers
- Technology integrated into curriculum units; transition from paper to on line unit assessments.
- Full implementation of Amplify, a digital Language Arts and ELD curriculum, in grades 6-8.
- Sharing effective practices from schools that made gains.

Monitoring

- K-8 principals write goals that outline how they will monitor instruction and use coaches, intervention teachers to support Language Arts and math.
- More frequent school visits and feedback to K-5 and 6-8 schools in greatest academic need.
