### Spotlight on New Actions

- Begin planning process for Theme-Based Schools to improve student opportunities
- Develop Multi-tiered System of Supports with district-wide common assessment to address learning loss and increase intentional teaching
- Proposed additional social workers to support social emotional needs of students at each school
- Proposed parent liaisons to connect home and school, support parent education sessions
- Increase parent outreach and education presentations
