Educator Effective Block Grant

California allocated \$1.5 billion for the following:

- 1. Coaching and mentoring of staff and beginning teacher or administrator induction
- 2. Programs that lead to effective instruction and improve instruction in literacy across all subject areas
- 3. Practices and strategies that reengage pupils and lead to accelerated learning
- 4. Strategies to implement social-emotional learning and other approaches that improve pupil well-being
- 5. Practices to create a positive school climate
- 6. Strategies to improve inclusive practices
- 7. Instruction and education to support implementing effective language acquisition programs for English learners
- 8. New professional learning networks for educators
- 9. Instruction, education, and strategies to incorporate ethnic studies curricula
- 10. Instruction, education, and strategies for certificated and classified educators in early childhood education or development.

Allocation and Use

- Funds are allocated for certificated and classified staff as reported in CALPADS and CBEDS as of October 2020.
- Paramount Unified will receive \$3,525,032
- Funds may be spent in any, or all the fiscal years from 2021-22 to 2025-26

Developing a Plan

The following questions were discussed to develop the plan:

- How many new teachers and administrators do we currently have in PUSD?
- How do we currently provide professional development, coaching, and mentoring to new teachers, teachers needing support and administrators?
- In an ideal district, how would we provide professional development and coaching/mentoring to new teachers, teachers needing support and administrators?
- How can we support a positive school climate centered on equity, cultural awareness, and inclusion?

- Support for Teachers Needing Improvement
- Support for Positive School Climate and Inclusion

 Educator Effectiveness Grant will be presented as an Action Item at the December 13th Board of Education meeting.


