English Learners Strengths

K-12	There was an increase in reclassification rates for all EL students.
K-5	Third grade EL students demonstrated increase in SBAC.
6-8	The D/F rates for EL students are similar to all students.
9-12	English Learners are scoring higher in ELA than math.

How can we support LTELs to move toward reclassification?





Support for All (Level 1)

 All school districts and schools can access resources and assistance.

Differentiated Assistance (Level 2)


 Assistance to school districts that meet eligibility criteria based on student group performance.

Intensive Support (Level 3)

 Assistance to school districts if there are persistent performance issues over multiple years.



• Cut scores are set for type of school and district



- Traditional Schools
 - High school students who could graduate with a high school diploma within four years of entering high school.
- Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS)
 - Modified graduation criteria have been adopted for DASS schools.

College Career Indicator

- Multiple measures are approved as indicating college or career readiness
 - Career Technical Education Pathway Completion
 - Grade 11 Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments in ELA and Math
 - Advanced Placement Exams
 - International Baccalaureate Exams
 - College Credit Course
 - A-G Completion
 - State Seal of Biliteracy
 - Military Science/Leadership
