P.U.S.D.'s Personal Physician Program

Mr. Craig Pyne, Senior Vice President with Paladina Health was in attendance and provided the Board with information on the District's Personal Physician Program.

Paramount Unified School District is excited to be able to offer the Personal Physician Program with Paladina Health, to all PPO plan members.

People will benefit from this program by:

- Save money: most clinic services are no cost to the patient
- Save time: get care at a convenient local clinic or by phone, email or text
- Get peace of mind: enjoy 24/7 access to your doctor via cell for urgent health needs

Delaying care is a huge problem. Almost two-thirds of patients delay care because of:

- Financial reasons
- Work or other commitments
- Takes too long to get answers to simple questions
- Poor service experiences in the healthcare community

The Comprehensive scope of services include primary care, basic urgent care, comprehensive physical exams, generic medications, inoffice labs and care coordination with specialists.

In summary, with this program, there is no co-pays (including in-clinic meds), convenience (local clinic, 24/7 phone access for urgent matters, your own personal physician for questions), privacy (Paladin is a separate company and subject to all state and federal privacy laws such as HIPAA), it reduces personal leave time to see a doctor and the program is also for dependents.
