At the July 11, 2016 Board meeting, the Board approved proceeding with an updated 2016 Community Survey (“2016 Community Survey”) for the primary purpose of obtaining input from the community regarding the District’s remaining priority school facilities projects and measuring the potential support levels for a 2016 Bond Measure needed for funding the full implementation of the remaining projects. The updated Community Survey was conducted by Fairbank, Maslin, Maullin & Metz (“FM3”) from July 20th through July 31st.

FM3 has prepared a summary of both the survey methodology and the results of the Key components tested in the District’s 2016 Community Survey for Board review.

Representatives from FM3 and CFS will be in attendance to present a summary of the 2016 Community Survey results and answer questions that the Board may have.
