

- Track starts in Artesia and will end downtown
- Most of route has been determined with the exception of the where the final portion will end up (union station, Temple, etc.)
- There will be 6 Park and Ride stations, one is in
  Paramount at to the West of Paramount and
  Rosecrans
- Based on environmental impact and traffic some tracks will be elevated and some will be at ground level

#### Paramount Specifics


- The station will be elevated
- Track will be elevated over paramount BLVD and Downey BLVD
- Track may drop to ground level as it passes between campuses.
- Sound walls will be installed near the High School (8 feet high)
- The crossover bridge will be removed, and a tunnel will be installed.
  - o School will have control of gates
  - o Lights and security cameras will be installed
- Paramount City would like to incorporate a walking and bike path

- Project is estimated at 6.6 Billion
- Measure M and R fund 4 Billion, so other financing is being researched
