- Quiet

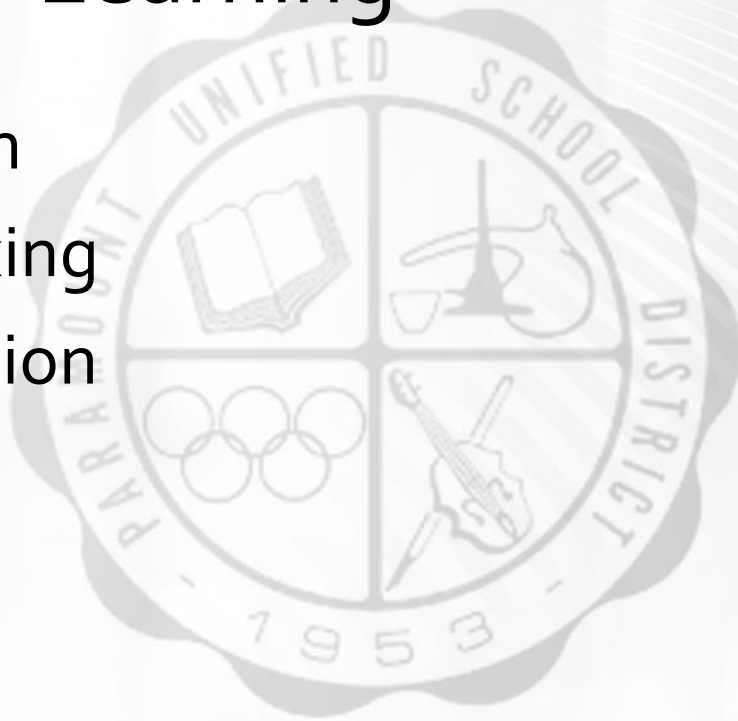






# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning

- Technology-friendly



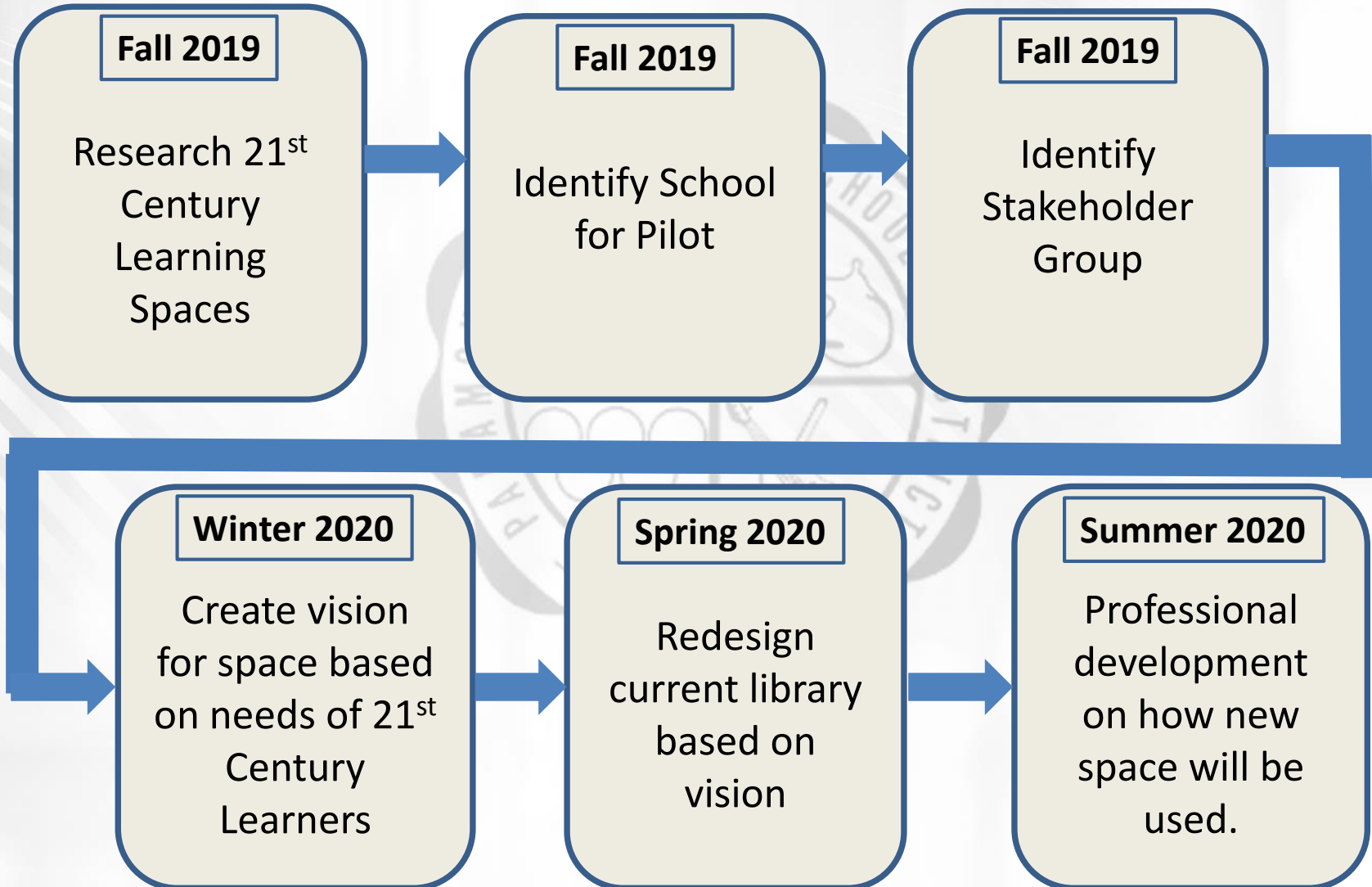


The library design will be internal only with a focus on:

- Use of resources

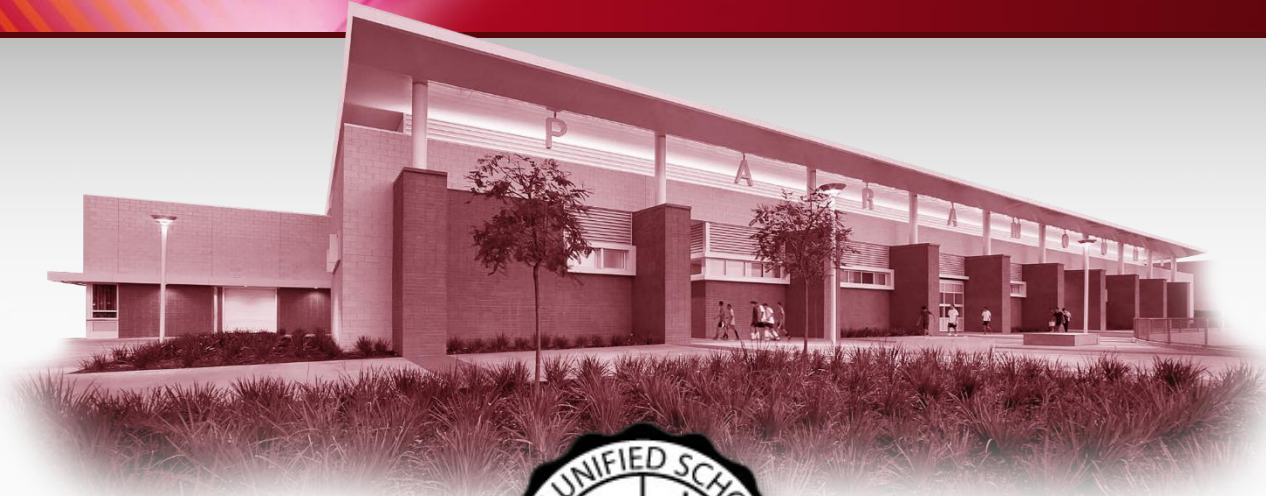
