

Monday, September 21, 2020 Special Meeting of Board of Education - Conducted Telephonically 5:30 p.m.

The agenda for each Board of Education meeting is posted 72 hours in advance of each regular meeting and 24 hours before a special meeting. Closed Session may be conducted in accordance with applicable sections of California law.

On March 12, 2020, the Governor issued an Executive Order N-25-20 suspending parts of the Brown Act that included the following:

All requirements in... the Brown Act expressly or impliedly requiring the physical presence of members, the clerk or other personnel of the body, or of the public as a condition of participation in or quorum for a public meeting are hereby waived." This means that Board Members may attend meetings remotely (i.e., by telephone or teleconference). Further, Board Meetings can proceed even if a quorum of the Board - or the entire Board - is participating remotely. This change also means that posting notices a the remote location and public access to the remote location are suspended, as well.

In compliance with the American with Disabilities Act, those requiring special assistance, to access written documents being discussed at the Board meeting, or to otherwise participate at Board meetings, please contact the Superintendent's Office at 562-602-6011 by 12:00 p.m., Monday, September 21, 2020 to enable the District to make reasonable arrangements.

The agenda shall provide members of the public the opportunity to address the Board regarding agenda items before or during the Board's consideration of the item. The agenda also provides members of the public an opportunity to testify at regular meetings on matters which are not on the agenda but which are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board.

Senate Bill 98, written to address school districts' needs in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, eliminates the requirement for a Local Control and Accountability Plan for the 2020-21 school-year and replaces it with the

Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan. The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan was reviewed by parent committees including the PAC and EL-PAC and posted on the Paramount Unified School District website for review and comment by the public. On September 14, 2020 a public hearing on the Plan was held; after approval, the plan will be submitted electronically to Los Angeles County Office of Education.
