

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ELEMENTARY & MIDDLE SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL 2023

1. What are the program offerings?

- Academic Program
 - The summer school academic program will be taught by PUSD teachers for grades 1-8, and the instruction will focus on literacy and math skills.
 - Kindergarten programs will be held at the same summer school location, and the program will be run by our partner Think Together.
- Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P)
 - The Expanded learning Opportunities Program is an optional enrichment program available to PUSD students. Parents will have the option to extend the summer school day by enrolling their child(ren) in ELO-P in the afternoon.
 - ELO-P provides enrichment activities in subjects such as sports, the arts, STEM, culinary, and more.
 - For specific locations and times for the ELO-P portion, please see below.
 - The program is free, but parents must complete an application from our program partner, Think Together.

2. Where are the locations and times? (Breakfast will be available 30 minutes before the instructional program starts. Lunch will also be provided.)

3. How will I know which summer school location my child will attend?

- If your student does not typically attend school at one of the summer school sites, your student will be placed at a school nearby.
- If you applied by May 12th, your child is guaranteed a spot in summer school, and you will be notified of your child's summer school location the week of May 29th. The information will be emailed to the email you provided on the Parent Square application.
- If you applied after May 12th, you will be notified the week of June 5th if your student has been accepted to summer school and the school location.
- If your student attends a program through Special Education, the Special Education Department will notify you of the location of your child's program.

4. Who is eligible for Summer School?

- All currently enrolled students are eligible for summer school.
- Incoming kindergarten students who have enrolled for the 2023-24 school year are also eligible to attend summer school. The kindergarten program will be held at the summer school elementary locations, and the program will be facilitated by our ELO-P partner, Think Together.
- Students entering 6th-8th grade are eligible for the Middle School Summer Programs

5. Is there a deadline to apply for summer school?

- In order to secure a summer school spot for your child, please apply by May 12th. If you do not apply by May 12th, you will be placed on a waitlist and admitted as space permits.

6. What grade will my child be placed in for Summer School?

- Students will be placed in their grade for the 2023-24 school year.

7. Will transportation be offered to students?

- Yes, transportation will be available.
- If your student requires transportation as part of an IEP (Individualized education plans) please work with your IEP team for transportation needs.
- Transportation information will be sent to parents when they are notified of their school location. The notification will be sent during the week of May 29th, and it will be sent to the email that was provided on the Parent Square application.

8. Do students have to wear a uniform for Summer School?

- Wearing uniforms is NOT required for summer school.

9. What offerings are available to Special Education Students?

- Students with Individualized education plans (IEPs) are encouraged to take advantage of summer school offerings provided to all students. For eligible students for Extended School Year (ESY) services designated within their IEP, parents will receive a separate registration form from their case carrier.

10. Will breakfast and lunch be served?

- Breakfast will be served 30 minutes before the instructional program starts and all students are eligible for breakfast.
- Lunch will be served at the end of the instructional program, and all students are eligible.

11. What are the dates?

- Summer School will be held over 5 weeks. The dates are noted below.

Week 1 (M-Th) – June 12-15

Week 2 (Tu-F) – June 20-23

Week 3 (M-Th) - June 26-29

Week 4 (M, W-F) - July 3, 5-7

Week 5 (M-Th) - July 10-13
