#### When do the classes start?

New modules start approximately every 5 weeks. Call our office for specifics.

#### Which days?

Monday – Thursday

#### What time?

4:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

#### **How long** is the program?

20 weeks – 4 modules of 5 weeks each...plus... 160 hours of externship (4 more weeks)

#### How much does it cost?

\$695 at enrollment \$120 every two weeks for the rest of the trimester \$1,895\* **TOTAL** 

#### What is the <u>refund</u> policy?

Refunds will only be accepted within the first three (3) days of class, with a receipt. If you receive books and attended class, your refund will be prorated. A 15% processing fee also applies. All refunds must be requested in writing, in the main office. Please allow up to 2 weeks for processing: You will be notified when your refund in processed.

#### What is the **externship**?

With your help, the teacher sets you up in an actual work place where you'll be performing MA duties (without pay). Many students go on to get paid jobs at their externship sites. Sites can be nearby or further away, depending on you, your goals, and your circumstances. The teacher will explain more in class. <a href="Note">Note</a>: You will NOT be allowed to serve your externship until you are current with your fees (see above).

#### **How** will I be taught?

You'll be taught theory and hands-on in a setting that is equipped with functioning equipment—that in some cases is the envy of externship sites like clinics and doctor's offices.

#### **What** will I study?

All that is necessary to be ready to take and pass the MA exam

#### What are the **prerequisites**?

The class will be taught in English, and the teaching materials are in English. There will be quite a lot of math involved. You need a high school diploma or GED by the time you reach your externship. You need to be able to work in the U.S. to participate in the externship or take the MA exam.

#### Where will the classes be taught?

In the new multi-million dollar science building at Paramount High School
